MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

The Alabama Academy of Radiology will hold its Annual Meeting on Saturday, April 12, 2003. All members are cordially invited to attend. The meeting will be held at the Wynfrey Hotel in Birmingham. There will be separate sub-specialty sessions offered prior to the business meeting. These will begin at 8:00 am, and the meeting will conclude with a luncheon at noon.

Beginning at 8:00 am, Dr. Jimmy Morros will moderate a session stressing Interventional Radiology by updating participants in current interventional techniques and related clinical and scientific issues involved in performance of various interventional radiology procedures.

At 9:00 am, Dr. Sandy Martin will moderate a session showing various Musculoskeletal MRI examinations, with an emphasis on finding the cause of the patient's pain, which often involves looking beyond the obvious anatomy to find the subtle pathology. Some examples of pitfalls in musculoskeletal imaging will also be documented.

Next, Dr. Jason Williams, resident at the University of South Alabama will do a presentation explaining the advantages of PET/

CT imaging, as well as the protocol, and possible pitfalls of PET and PET/CT imaging.

As a conclusion to the CME presentations, Dr. Greg Gum will do a presentation on disaster response by providing a historical insight into bio-warfare, discuss the current preparations in the state of Alabama and address current controversies.

BYLAWS CHANGE
